Application Fees

An application fee is payable when the application form is submitted. No application will be considered if the fee or proof of payment thereof is not attached. This is non-refundable.

Acceptance Fees

Within two weeks of confirmation of provisional acceptance of the first year students and second year transfer students, the applicable forms, together with the acceptance fee must be returned to FEDISA.

This amount will be credited to the student's account and will guarantee the student's seat in the class.

Should the student cancel or fail to take his/her place in the class, this amount will NOT be refunded or deferred.

Please note that failure to pay the acceptance fee within the prescribed period, will result in the candidate being placed on a waiting list, until such time as this amount is paid and the candidates placement on the programme is therefore not guaranteed.

Registration Fees
